Medication Requirements

We are delighted your child will be with us at Camp Creation this year.

It is required if your child will attend camp with medications ~ that you grant permission to the Camp Nurse to administer both prescription and over-the-counter medications as listed on the enclosed Medication Information Form.

To prevent problems with giving your child's medication, your child MUST have this form completed thoroughly and accurately. Medications will not be given unless they are listed on this form. If your child will be receiving more than four (4) medications, then please use an additional form.

All medications must be brought to camp in the original pharmacy container with the child's name, drug, and dosage clearly marked on the label. For over-the-counter medications (Tylenol, Claritin, etc.), it must be clearly noted on the Medication Information Form the dosage that is to be given to your child. Giving medications to your child is governed by Washington State Law, and we must follow those rules ~ no exceptions!

All medications are to be placed in a Zip-Lock bag in the original pharmacy container, clearly marked with your child's name, and then sealed.

Please have your child bring the completed Medication Information Form and their medications with them when they come to Camp Creation.

If we do not receive the medications in the manner described above, with a signed consent form, you will be asked to take your child back home. Please read this form carefully and prepare ahead of time.
